ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS*

- Available for a child who either enrolls or who is currently enrolled in a Natural Beginnings Program. (The opportunity to receive this scholarship is once per household.)
- Household meets the income guidelines** adjusted from the Income Eligibility Guidelines as set by the 2020 National School Lunch Act. (Section 9(b)(1) of the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1758(b)(1)(A))

*No current Kendall County Forest Preserve District Commissioner or Forest Foundation Trustee family members or Kendall County Forest Preserve District or Natural Beginnings employees' family members are eligible to apply.
